



FACT SHEET

Marloth Park situated on the Crocodile River on the southern boundary of Kruger national Park.

Unique in the sense that game are roam freely around the houses. Hence the opportunity to see Impala, Kudu, Waterbuck, Nyala, Water Buck, Reed Buck, Wildebeest, Buffalo, Giraffe, Warthogs, Duiker, Zebra, Mongooses, baboons and monkeys around the cottages is very good. Elephant, Rhino, Hippo's and the Big 5 can also often be seen down at the river from behind the safety of a game fence.

Birding is an absolute must at Marloth with a huge variety seen without having to leave the house.

Marloth Park has a petrol filling station and two shopping "centre's" - Trading Post & Bush Centre. Most of your essentials can be bought from these two stores ie. Milk, bread, fire wood etc.

The Bush Centre also has a very nice pub that offers reasonably priced meals and drinks. They also have a pool area for patrons. Many of the other lodges in Marloth Park also offer restaurant and pub facilities.

- Komatipoort (small town with shopping facilities) 20km
- Male lane (small town with excellent shopping facilities) 30 km
- Access to Kruger National Park via Crocodile Bridge 10 km and Male lane Gate 20 km
- Mozambique 20 km
- Swaziland 60 km
- Game viewing in Marloth Park
- Mpumalanga, Burkes Luck Potholes, Gods Window, etc 120 km
- Walking distance to Kruger Park fence, with great views (big 5) into the park.

● **Directions to Marloth Park:**

- From Johannesburg / Pretoria follow the N4 from Witbank.
- After the Machado Toll Gate, turn left, Schoemanskloof Road towards Nelspruit
- Continue through Nelspruit toward Maputo
- Approximately 10km after Hectorspruit turn left to Marloth park (Gravel Road)
- Continue on the gravel road for approximately 5 km, pass through gate (Stand 2747)
- Continue on Olifant Weg for approximately 10 km
- Turn Left into Waterbok Road, drive approx 200m
- At the T-turn right into Swartwitpens Street. Continue for approximately 500m
- Turn left into Nyala Street, continue for approximately 500m
- Turn left into Civit Street. Continue for approximately 20m
- Turn left towards the House.
